INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the proposals for the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate, the extension of the Issue Mandate and the re-election of the retiring Directors, and to seek your approval at the AGM in connection with, inter alia, the aforesaid proposals.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

ISSUE MANDATE

On 10 August 2023, an ordinary resolution was passed by the Shareholders to give a general mandate to the Directors to allot, issue and deal with additional Shares or other securities and/or sell or transfer treasury shares (if any). Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM. It is therefore proposed to renew such general mandate at the AGM. The Issue Mandate will be proposed at the AGM to grant a general mandate to the Directors to allot, issue and otherwise deal with additional Shares up to a limit equal to 20% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding treasury shares, if any) as at the date of passing of the resolution approving the Issue Mandate.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 684,750,000 Shares. Assuming that there is no change in the issued share capital between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of passing of the resolution approving the Issue Mandate, the maximum number of Shares or securities which may be issued pursuant to the Issue Mandate will be 136,950,000 Shares, representing 20% of the total number of Shares in issue (excluding treasury shares, if any) as at the date of passing of the resolution approving the Issue Mandate.

Ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Issue Mandate and authorize the extension of the Issue Mandate, details of which are set out in ordinary resolutions numbers 4 and 6 respectively in the notice of AGM.

REPURCHASE MANDATE

On 10 August 2023, an ordinary resolution was passed by the Shareholders to give a general mandate to the Directors to exercise the powers of the Company to repurchase its own Shares. Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the number of the issued Shares is 684,750,000 Shares. Assuming that there is no change in the issued share capital between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of passing of the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate, the maximum number of Shares which may be repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate will be 68,475,000 Shares, representing 10% of the total number of Shares in issue (excluding treasury shares, if any) as at the date of passing of the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate.

An ordinary resolution will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate, details of which are set out in ordinary resolution number 5 in the notice of AGM.

An explanatory statement as required under the Listing Rules, giving certain information regarding the Repurchase Mandate, is set out in the Appendix I to this circular.

RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS

The Board currently consists of six Directors, Mr. Chan Lap Wai Gary, Mr. Chan Lap Chuen Edmond, Ms. Chan Chin Ying Amanda, Mr. Li Hon Hung, *BBS, MH, JP*, Mr. Cheng Chi Hung and Mr. Wong Yip Kong.

Pursuant to Articles 83(3), 84(1) and 84(2) of the Articles of Association, Ms. Chan Chin Ying Amanda and Mr. Cheng Chi Hung will retire at the AGM and will be eligible, offer themselves for re-election.

According to the Listing Rules and the board diversity policy adopted by the Company (the “**Board Diversity Policy**”), the nomination committee of the Company (the “**Nomination Committee**”) will, among other things, undertake the nomination and selection of independent non-executive Director candidates on the completion of their specified terms and make relevant recommendations to the Board.

Furthermore, when changes to composition of the Board or members of any committee of the Company are required or when casual vacancies arise, the Nomination Committee shall adhere to the principles stated in the Board Diversity Policy. The Nomination Committee will take into account the existing composition of the Board and the business requirements of the Group, and nominate potential candidates by reference to their capacity and the selection criteria to the Board for approval.

The Nomination Committee had, among other things, having regard to the Board Diversity Policy, evaluated the skills, experience, background, expertise and performance of Ms. Chan Chin Ying Amanda and Mr. Cheng Chi Hung during the period from respective dates of appointment to 31 March 2024 and found their performance satisfactory.

Mr. Cheng Chi Hung has met the independence criteria under the Listing Rules. Moreover, each of Mr. Cheng Chi Hung has given confirmation of independence to the Company. With due consideration on the above factors, the Board believes that Mr. Cheng Chi Hung is independent.

In view of the knowledge, experience and skills of Mr. Cheng Chi Hung in business management, operation, financial accounting, corporate governance and compliance, the Board believes that their expertise will enable them to fulfill his roles as independent non-executive Directors effectively and can provide useful and constructive opinion and make contribution to the Board and future development of the Company.

Based on the background of Mr. Cheng Chi Hung including but not limited to gender, cultural and educational background, ethnicity, professional experience, skills and knowledge, it is believed that Mr. Cheng Chi Hung can contribute to diversity of the Board.

Having considered the above aspects and in view of the contribution that Mr. Cheng Chi Hung has made to the Board, his re-elections will be in the best interests of the Company and its Shareholders as a whole.

Brief biographical details of the retiring Directors proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

RE-APPOINTMENT OF THE AUDITORS

Messrs. Elite Partners CPA Limited will retire as the auditors of the Company at the AGM and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-appointment.

The Board, upon the recommendation of the audit committee of the Board, proposed to re-appoint Messrs. Elite Partners CPA Limited as the auditors of the Company and to hold office until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The notice convening the AGM, which contains, inter alia, ordinary resolutions to approve the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate, the extension of the Issue Mandate and the re-election of the retiring Directors is set out on pages 14 to 18 of this circular.

VOTING BY WAY OF POLL

All the resolutions at the AGM shall be taken by poll in accordance with Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules and Article 66(1) of the Articles, except where the chairman of the meeting, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution that relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands pursuant to the Listing Rules.

Pursuant to Article 66(1) of the Articles of Association, subject to any special rights or restrictions as to voting for the time being attached to any Shares, at any general meeting every Shareholder present in person (or in the case of a Shareholder being a corporation, by its duly authorized representative) or by proxy shall have one vote for each Share registered in his name in the Company's register of members.

An announcement on the poll vote results will be made by the Company after the AGM in the manner prescribed under Rule 13.39(5) of the Listing Rules.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

A proxy form for use at the AGM is enclosed herein. Such form of proxy is also published on the websites of the Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited (<http://www.hkexnews.hk>) and the Company (<http://www.simonandsons.com.hk>). Whether or not you intend to attend the AGM, you are requested to complete the proxy form in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and return the same to the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong as soon as possible and in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the AGM or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the proxy form will not preclude Shareholders from attending and voting in person at the AGM, or any adjourned meeting, should they so wish, and in such event, the form of proxy previously submitted shall be deemed to have revoked.

RESPONSIBILITY STATEMENT

This circular, for which the Directors collectively and individually accept full responsibility, includes particulars given in compliance with the Listing Rules for the purpose of giving information with regard to the Group. The Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, confirm that to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this circular is accurate and complete in all material respects and not misleading or deceptive, and there are no other matters the omission of which would make any statement herein or this circular misleading.

RECOMMENDATION

The Directors believe that the proposals mentioned in this circular, including the proposals to re-elect the retiring Directors, to re-appoint the Company's auditors and to grant to the Directors the Issue Mandate and the Repurchase Mandate are in the best interests of the Company as well as to its Shareholders. Accordingly, the Directors recommend that all the Shareholders should vote in favour of all the relevant resolutions relating to aforesaid matters.

This appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules, to provide information reasonably necessary to enable you to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against Ordinary Resolution 5 in respect of the approval of the Repurchase Mandate.

1. EXERCISE OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Exercise in full of the Repurchase Mandate, on the basis of 684,750,000 Shares in issue at the Latest Practicable Date, could result in up to 68,475,000 Shares being repurchased by the Company during the period up to (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles of Association or any applicable laws to be held; or (iii) the revocation, variation or renewal of the Repurchase Mandate by ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in general meeting, whichever occurs first.

To the extent that any treasury shares are deposited with CCASS pending resale on the Stock Exchange, the Company will adopt appropriate measures to ensure that it does not exercise any shareholders' rights or receive any entitlements which would otherwise be suspended under the applicable laws if those shares were registered in the Company's own name as treasury shares. These measures may include approval by the Board that: (i) the Company will not (or will procure its broker not to) give any instructions to Hong Kong Securities Clearing Company Limited to vote at general meetings for the treasury shares deposited with CCASS; and (ii) in the case of dividends or distributions, the Company will withdraw the treasury shares from CCASS, and either re-register them in its own name as treasury shares or cancel them, in each case before the record date for the dividends or distributions.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

Repurchases of Shares will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value of the Company and/or its earnings per Share.

Subject to the compliance with the Listing Rules and all applicable laws and regulations, the Company may cancel any Shares it repurchased and/or hold such Shares as treasury shares for subsequent sale or transfer subject to consideration of factors including market conditions and the Group's capital management needs at the relevant time of the repurchases.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with its memorandum and articles of association and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands. The law of the Cayman Islands provides that the amount to be repaid in connection with a share repurchase may be paid from the profits of the Company and/or the proceeds of a new issue of Shares made for the purpose of the repurchase or out of capital, if the Company can, immediately following such payment, pay its debts as they fall due in the ordinary course of business. The Company may not purchase securities on the Stock Exchange for a consideration other than cash or for settlement otherwise than in accordance with the trading rules of the Stock Exchange from time to time.

4. UNDERTAKING

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited financial statements contained in the annual report of the Company for the year ended 31 March 2024) in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full. However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or on its gearing position which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the powers of the Company to make repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate and in accordance with the Listing Rules, the memorandum of association and articles of association of the Company, the laws of Hong Kong and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

None of the Directors nor, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, their close associates (as defined in the Listing Rules), have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company or its subsidiaries under the Repurchase Mandate if such is approved by the Shareholders.

Neither this explanatory statement nor the proposed granting of Repurchase Mandate has any unusual features.

No core connected persons (as defined in the Listing Rules) have notified the Company that they have a present intention to sell Shares to the Company or its subsidiaries, or have undertaken not to do so, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

5. EFFECT OF TAKEOVERS CODE AND PUBLIC FLOAT

If on the exercise of the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become(s) obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rules 26 and 32 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, as far as the Directors are aware, Creative Elite Global Limited was interested in 495,000,000 Shares, representing 72.29% of the issued share capital of the Company (excluding treasury shares, if any). Creative Elite Global Limited is owned as to 45%, 28%, 18% and 9% by Mr. Chan Lap Wai Gary, Mr. Chan Lap Chuen Edmond, Ms. Chan Chin Ying Amanda and Ms. Chan Chin Ling Chrissy respectively. Based on such shareholdings and in the event that the Directors exercised in full the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate (and assuming all such repurchased Shares are subsequently cancelled), the shareholding of Creative Elite Global Limited would be increased to approximately 80.32% of the issued share capital of the Company (excluding treasury shares, if any). Such increase would not give rise to an obligation to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code but would reduce the percentage of Shares held by the public to below the prescribed minimum percentage of 25% required by the Listing Rules.

The Directors will use their best endeavours to ensure that the Repurchase Mandate will not be exercised to the extent that the number of Shares held by the public being reduced to less than 25% as required under the Listing Rules.

6. SHARE PURCHASED MADE BY THE COMPANY

The Company has not repurchased any Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) in the six months preceding the Latest Practicable Date.

The following are the particulars of the retiring Directors proposed to be re-elected at the AGM:

1. Ms. CHAN Chin Ying Amanda

Ms. CHAN Chin Ying Amanda (陳千瑩女士), aged 64, is our executive Director and a director of Favourable Year, Rainbow Republic and Simon & Sons. She is also one of our controlling shareholders. Ms. Amanda Chan has over 42 years of experience in the building and construction industry in Hong Kong. She is responsible for the overall administration, maintaining quality control and monitoring our safety and environmental compliance. Between March 1982 and October 1986, Ms. Amanda Chan worked as an assistant administration manager in Simon Construction & Engineering Company, a sole proprietorship principally engaged in piling works as a registered contractor in Hong Kong and established by Mr. Simon Chan, our founder. She was responsible for the overall management of its financial and operation matters. Since November 1986, Ms. Amanda Chan has been a director of Simon & Sons, our principal operating subsidiary, and has been responsible for the overall administration and matters relating to human resources of the Simon & Sons. She also assumed the roles of administration manager between November 1986 and March 1998, quality manager between April 1998 and January 2008 and the Certified Quality and Environmental Manager since 2008 in Simon & Sons.

Ms. Amanda Chan obtained a Diploma in Business Management from Society of Business Practitioners in the United Kingdom in June 2001. She has been a fellow member of The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Auditors since January 2008. She was admitted as a Certified Quality Manager in January 2008, a Certified Environmental Manager in January 2008 and a Certified Internal Auditor of Quality and Environmental in January 2008.

Ms. Amanda Chan is the sister of Mr. Gary Chan, our executive Director and Chairman, and Mr. Edmond Chan, our executive Director and Chief Executive Officer.

The proposed term of service of Ms. Chan is 3 years commencing from the date of appointment effective upon conclusion of the AGM. Ms. Chan is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at the AGM in accordance with the Articles of Association. Her emoluments as a Director for the year ended 31 March 2024 were HK\$1,236,000. The emoluments of Ms. Chan were determined and reviewed annually by the Board with reference to his level of experience and responsibilities with the Group.

2. Mr. CHENG Chi Hung

Mr. CHENG Chi Hung (鄭志洪先生), aged 64, is our independent non-executive Director. Mr. Cheng has over 26 years of experience in auditing and accounting. His previous working experience includes the following:

Mr. Cheng obtained a Master of Business Administration and a Postgraduate Certificate in Information Technology from The Open University of Hong Kong (currently known as Hong Kong Metropolitan University) in December 1999 and December 2001, respectively. He also obtained a HKICPA Diploma in Insolvency from the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants in June 2004. Mr. Cheng has been practising as a Certified Public Accountant and a Certified Tax Adviser/Chartered Tax Adviser (Non-practising) in Hong Kong since February 2005 and June 2010, respectively. He was admitted as an associate member of the Hong Kong Society of Accountants (currently known as the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants) and the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants in January 1996, a fellow member of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants in January 2001, and an associate member of the Taxation Institute of Hong Kong in May 2010.

The proposed term of service of Mr. Cheng is 3 years commencing from the date of appointment effective upon conclusion of the AGM. Mr. Cheng is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at the AGM in accordance with the Articles of Association. His emoluments as a Director for the year ended 31 March 2024 were HK\$180,000. The emoluments of Mr. Cheng were determined and reviewed annually by the Board with reference to his level of experience and responsibilities with the Group.

Save as disclosed above, to the best of the knowledge of the Directors having made all reasonable enquiries, each of the above Directors:

- (i) has not held any other directorships in the last three years in any listed public company in Hong Kong or overseas;
- (ii) is not related to any Directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders of the Company;
- (iii) is not interested in any Shares within the meaning of the Part XV of the SFO; and
